The caduceus symbol was adopted by the American Dental Association in 1965 as the official emblem of dentistry. The Greek letters Δ (delta), for dentistry, and O (omicron), for odont (tooth) form the periphery of the design. In the background are 32 leaves and 20 berries, representative of the permanent and deciduous teeth. Lilac is the official academic color of dentistry.
