The division has state-of-the-art clinical facilities based at the School of Dentistry and has strong faculty and staff support. The program has both school and hospital based clinical environments. Candidates for this position should have a D.D.S. or equivalent degree and advanced training in pediatric dentistry. ABPD certification or equivalent is desirable but not required. Prior teaching experience, demonstrated scholarly activity, and record of service and leadership to the profession and specialty is desirable. Responsibilities will include didactic and clinical teaching in the predoctoral and/or residency programs, scholarship and service activities. Leadership opportunities are available for appropriate candidates. A State of Michigan license is required; however, a Clinical Academic Limited License may be available for qualified candidates. Candidates must be eligible to work in the USA. Faculty practice opportunities are available. Salary and rank will be commensurate with experience and training.
